

Terms and Conditions Participants
Nawaka 2022



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Introduction

Nawaka 2022 is a summer camp for scouts which takes place near, on and in the water. The camp lasts for 10 days. Together with other groups from inside, and outside of the Netherlands, you and your section will camp in one of the subcamps on the International Scout and Guide Center Scouting Estate Zeewolde. The program is filled with big, interesting, and awesome activities. Taking part in this camp will be something you will always remember.

Nawaka 2022 is organized for the following participants:

- a. Youth participant who are, in 2022, a member of a scout-, or explorer section of a scouting group and are at least 11 years old but not older than 17 years. Youth participants that are a little older than the standard age limit of their section, but are registered as a youth member with their section are allowed to participate, conforming with the age limits of their section:
 - Scouts: 11 to 15 years old
 - Explorers: 15 to 18 years old
- b. Participation is only possible as part of a section, and sections cannot mix age groups or join with sections of other age groups. This is because each age group will camp in different places.
- c. A section consists of youth participants and leaders. All leaders are of the minimum age requirement for their section.
 - Scouts: minimum age of 18 years
 - Explorers: minimum age of 21 years
- d. The guideline for the leader – youth participants ratio is 1 to 4 for scouts and explorer sections. Always with a minimum of two leaders per section.
- e. The registration has to be approved by the organization of Nawaka 2022 if the ratio is lower than the threshold mentioned above.
- f. For sections that have a lower ratio, as mentioned above, leaders will be (partially) deployed to help with tasks that support the organization
- g. The leaders attending are expected, besides taking care of their sections, to make some time available to help with tasks that support the organization and activities of the camp. Before the start of Nawaka, the attending leaders will be sent details regarding what is expected of them.

1 General terms and conditions

1.1 Vereniging Scouting Nederland is the organizing party for Nawaka 2022 and the legal counterparty for participants.

1.2. Nawaka 2022 is being held on the International Scout and Guide Center Scouting Estate Zeewolde.

1.3. All youth participants and leaders will arrive on the terrain, on Monday the 8th of August 2022 within the assigned timeslot and will leave the terrain on Wednesday the 17th of August 2022, also within the assigned timeslot.

1.4. Participation is at your own risk.

1.5. The camp rules of Nawaka 2022 are inextricably connected to these Terms and Conditions for Participants. By agreeing to these terms and conditions, participants automatically agree to the camp rules. All participants are expected to keep to the camp rules at all times. The organization has the authority to expel anyone who does not keep to the rules. The camp rules and the code of conduct will be published at our website <https://nawaka.scouting.nl/>.

1.6. All international participants must be members of WOSM or WAGGGS through their national scouting organization.

1.7. It is of vital importance that we can provide a safe and open environment during Nawaka 2022. Each international group needs to provide a letter from their national scouting organisation. The letter is stating that you are member of the national scouting organisation and that you are member of WOSM/WAGGGS. You have to send the letter to international@nawaka.scouting.nl.

1.8. All leaders of the section must be able provide either a certificate of conduct or a letter stating they went through safe from harm training. This is the responsibility of their section.

1.9. Sections that are bringing their own boating equipment to Nawaka, have to do this in consultation with Port Services. For more information email international@nawaka.scouting.nl

1.10 Sections will bring their material with them on their day of arrival and take it home on their day of departure. It is only possible to leave behind normal household waste

2 Registration

2.1 Registration will be through a form in Scouts Online (SOL) per section.

2.2 Registration is possible from the 1st of September 2021. Registrations will be accepted as long as the maximum amount of participants per age group is not reached. Registration closes on the 30th of December 2021.

2.3 Each individual section will be registered by one contact only. On the registration form the number of youth participants and leaders will be supplied, where this is asked.

2.4. After registration of the section, each individual participant of that section needs to be registered as well. The contact of the section is responsible, and held accountable, for completing all registration information truthfully.

2.5. The contact of the section declares that he/she is competent, able and allowed to register in the name of all participants of the section and that the legal guardians of the participants are in accord with the participant terms and conditions if applicable.

2.6 The group form must be completed by 30th of December 2021 via SOL.

2.7 Up until the 30th of December 2021 the amount of participants can be changed without charge.

2.8 After the 30th of December 2021, no fees will be returned if the number of participants is lowered (see paragraph 3.7). More participants can be added until the 1st of May 2022, as long as the maximum number of participants per section has not been reached.

2.9. Adjusting the number of participants or cancelation is only possible until the 1st of May 2022. Replacing a participant remains possible after this date without extra fees.

2.10. All personal information (like diets) of participants on the individual registration forms need to be completed by the 1st of May 2022.

2.11 Medical information will not be included on the registration form. A separate health form will be available from January 2022 via <https://nawaka.nl/>. Sections are responsible and held accountable for filling out health forms for each participant and keeping them available for the duration of the camp.

2.12 After registration has been completed and sent, the contact of the section will receive an email with automatic confirmation with a registration number.

2.13 On the registration form, dietary preferences can be mentioned. Dietary preferences can be adjusted until the 1st of May 2022. The organization provides for a selected amount of diets, as mentioned in the registration form. Queries about specific dietary preferences can be made through the Information point, via international@nawaka.scouting.nl. Support of specific dietary preferences is not guaranteed but will be assessed per each individual situation.

2.14 On the day of arrival, all information will be checked. This includes personal information of participants, the number of participants and the dietary preferences.

2.15 All sailing equipment needs to be signed up via the sign-up sheet.

3 Participation fee & payment

3.1 Participation fees, including registration fee:

3.2 The participation fee includes:

- Food, from dinner on the day of arrival until breakfast on the day of departure
- Participation package
- Campsite facilities and a complete program
- Information during the complete process

3.3 The participation fee does not include:

- Transport of participants and their luggage to and from the campsite
- All gear that is needed for your section to camp. The organization expects that all sections arrange their own tents, cooking gear, etc.
- Parking costs for cars for participants, tickets are sold separately.

3.4 The registration fees need to be paid by the 28th of February 2022. On the 1st of May 2022, the rest of the fees need to be paid. You will receive an invoice for the amount due.

3.5. If the participation fees have not been paid by arrival, the contact of the section will need to pay the entire sum at arrival. Only after the entire sum has been paid are the participants allowed to enter the camp terrain.

3.6 No invoice will be sent. An invoice can be downloaded from sign-up in SOL.

3.7 Cancellation is possible until the 30th of December 2021 without added fees.

3.8. If cancellation happens between the 30th of December 2021 and the 1st of May 2022, the registration fees are still due. Registration of a replacement can still be done without added fees in this time.

3.9. Cancellation is not possible after the 1st of May of 2022. When canceling after this date, full payment of the registration and participation fees are still due. Registration of a replacement can still be done without added fees in this time.

3.10 A refund of (a part of) the fees will only be considered in exceptional cases. This decision will be made by the camp leader and the treasurer. Before a refund will be considered, sections will first have to address their own cancelation insurance. A request for a refund has to be made in writing addressed to the treasurer. This can be done through financien@nawaka.scouting.nl. This can be done until the 1st of August 2022.

3.11 if the organization decides to cancel participation before the date of the event, the participation fee will be refunded, except for costs for already delivered services.

3.12 if, due to forces beyond Scouting Nederland's control (Force Majeure) the event is cancelled, postponed or has to continue in a different form, Scouting Nederland can decide to postpone the event or cancel participation. If in a situation like this the agreement is terminated, paid participation fees will be refunded except for costs for already delivered services that cannot be undone.

4 Insurance

4.1 You have to arrange a travel and luggage insurance by yourself, starting at the day you leave till the day you will be back at home.

4.2. Scouting Nederland or the organization of The Dutch National Jamboree 2020 cannot be held accountable for loss, theft or damage of the property of participating members or sections during or traveling to the event.

5 Health and safety

5.1 By agreeing with these terms and conditions for participants, participants (or their lawful representative) accept receiving first aid care.

5.2 Participating groups and/or sections are responsible for the health forms of all participants, see section 2.11.

5.3 During participation of a nautical event participants have to adhere to the rules of NTR2020. These rules can be found on the website of Scouting Nederland <https://www.scouting.nl/ondersteuning/waterscouting/ntr-veiligheid>.

5.4 During water events all participants are obliged to wear a lifejacket unless the flag sign for that purpose is hoisted. A lifejacket is a jacket with enough buoyancy to turn someone on their back. A lifejacket is recognizable because of the number on it, 100N (minimum), preferably 150N or 275N. The number indicates the purpose of the jacket. During the obligatory inventory it is stated that for every crewmember one approved life jacket has to be on board. Life jackets that are not 100N, 150N or 275N, buoyancy aids and the like offer insufficient protection and are therefore not allowed.

6 Other

6.1 The organization uses sponsorships. It is necessary to prevent conflicts between sponsors, by making sure all sponsor activity goes through the organization. The rules for sponsor activities as well as the use of the logo and style of the organization are binding for all participants. More information about this can be found at <https://nawaka.nl/>.

6.2 The information given on the registration forms will exclusively be used for this event. The data will not be passed on to third parties and will be destroyed after the event. The data will only be accessible for people who are part of the organization and need this information to fulfill their role in the organization.

6.3 Among others, emails will be used by the organization to communicate with participants and relay information. Participants agree with receiving messages via their email address and are responsible for using the right email address when taking up contact with the organization. Additionally, they are responsible for providing the correct email address in SOL.

6.4 Every participant and contact that registered their section, will keep themselves informed about Nawaka 2022, be that through newsletters, website, mobile channels or other.

6.5 By registration, participants give permission to Scouting Nederland to make and use (moving) visual images during Nawaka 2022 and use these images for advertising purposes. If and when a participant wants to object to this, a message should be sent to info@nawaka.scouting.nl expressing their wishes and stating their name and their registration number.

6.6 Scouting Nederland and the organization can deny a participant making (moving) visual images in certain circumstances.

6.7 Participants are expected to behave in an appropriate manner and to keep to the camp rules of Nawaka 2022, as well as the code of conduct and the rules within Scouting Nederland. The organization has the right to exclude participants who do not keep to these rules, of (continued) participation of Nawaka 2022. Camp rules can be found at <https://nawaka.nl/>.

6.8 When excluded from the event and the terrain, all resulting costs, like an earlier return journey, are for the account of the participant.

6.9 Prices and rules are subject to change, like publication errors.

6.10 The organization is allowed to change or add to these terms and conditions for participants. Communication about the changed terms and conditions go through <https://nawaka.nl/>

6.11 Complaints about the procedure of the event can be sent to secretariaat@nawaka.scouting.nl. The organization of Nawaka 2022 will handle the complaints in the first instance. An objection against the handling of a complaint can be submitted with the dispute committee of Scouting Nederland via Team Juridische Zaken (juridischezaken@scouting.nl).

6.12 Scouting Nederland is only accountable for the loss, theft or damaging of property of participants when it can be demonstrated that this is the result of purposeful actions or negligence of the organization and/or Scouting Nederland.

- The acceptance of liability is limited to the value of the agreement of participation and never exceeds the amount that the liability insurer of Scouting Nederland in the relevant case pays out, increased by the amount of the deductible of Scouting Nederland that under the policy conditions is not at the expense of the insurer.
- Scouting Netherlands is not liable for financial insolvency of a service provider involved in the agreement.
- Scouting Nederland accepts no liability for damage that is covered via a health/accident, travel and/or cancellation insurance of the participant.
- Scouting Nederland is not liable for compensation for indirect or consequential damage (including but not limited to consequential damages, lost profits, loss of income, lost savings, and damage due to business interruption), or for damage suffered by the participant in the course of his profession or business.

6.13 In all account where these terms and conditions do not apply the organization of the Dutch National Jamboree 2020 has the authority to decide.

6.14 Scouting Nederland nor the organization of Nawaka 2022 can be held liable for loss, theft or damage of property of participants and/or participating groups during the event or during travel to and/or from the event.
